EDUCATION. Next weekend, children and their parents will be allowed to make use of free professional advice from psychologists, therapists and speech therapists.

The party "Check your child's speaking, reading, writing and counting" is organised by the Pedagogic University of Kraków. Calligraphy, origami and art therapy classes have also been prepared for children. During all three days of the party, one can listen to lectures and attend workshops lead by invited guests (including professor Jadwiga Cieszyńska, excellent psychologist and surdologopedics). The event will be accompanied by a book and school material sale.

One of the lecturers will be Krzysztof Cywiński, author of a revolutionary method of teaching mathematics. - *I will play a film which explains how to answer questions type: why do we multiply first and then perform addition? This is the first step for everyone with mathematical problems to finally like math* - says Cywiński.
